NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Dogs under the age of 4 months are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the show committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a publice person bbe pe enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in this trial the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for this reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked before the trial commences.
- The clubs will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for injured or ill dogs. Written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$25 fee will be charged for any check that bounces. The amount of the check and fee must be paid by cash, money order, or credit card. Anyone who owes monies to the CWCCA will not be able to enter and participate in any event until the debt is settled.

MEASURING INFORMATION

If your dog does **NOT** have a valid temporary (15 months to 2years old) or first permanent measurement after 2 years old, it is your responsibility to ensure that your dog is measured prior to the start of your first class. Judge Laura English is a VMO, and she has agreed to measure as time permits. If you need to be measured:

- Please allow plenty of time before your first class to get your needed measurement. The judge can measure only between classes, so please be considerate!
- Fill out the measurement form and then notify the Trial Secretary that you
 are available for measurement.
- If you need your second measurement for a permanent height card, you
 will need to be measured by an AKC rep or a VMO at this trial, but you do
 not have to be measured prior to your first run.
- Masks are REQUIRED during measuring. Only entered dogs will be measured.

RIBBONS AND PRIZES

- Qualifying Ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying score earned.
- Double Q ribbons and New Title ribbons will be available
- Placement rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each class, jump height and in each division.
- All placements will receive 1st through 4th will receive a hand towel.
- A MACH bar and MACH rosette will be awarded to anyone earning a MACH title. A PACH bar and PACH rosette will be awarded to anyone earning a PACH title

Criteria for the HIT: Qualifying scores in both Standard (STD) & Jumpers with Weaves (JWW) classes of the same trial are required. Each dog will be assigned points based on the STD class ENTERED for that trial (30 for Ex/Mas; 20 for Open; 10 for Novice). These points are added to the dog's speed points (judge's course time minus the dog's course time) plus the dog's score for each course. The dogs with the most points are HIT.

No Double Qs? Then Standard runs only will be used in the formulation of HIT.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is
 not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare
 FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option.
